



# TRUE/FALSE PHRASEOLOGY

## **General Volunteer : Basic Volunteer Level**

- Must commit 20 hours of volunteer work to the festival
- Grants you Free Q-ing for all films, while not on shift
- Access to the Volunteer Party and @ction Party after Midnight

## **Juggernaut Volunteer : the Highest Volunteer Level**

- Must commit 40 hours of volunteer work festival prior to and during the festival
- Six Free Tickets, which can be pick up starting at 9 am Friday, March 3
- One voucher to use the Silver Circle Q, Free Q-ing at for all films, while not on shift.
- Free screenings of select films post-festival at Ragtag Cinema
- Access to Volunteer Party and @ction Party

## **NRT : No Reserve Ticket**

- There are no available tickets at the Box Office
- This does not mean "Sold Out". There will always be space available via the Q!
- If a film is listed as NRT on the online schedule ([truefalse.org/program/schedule](http://truefalse.org/program/schedule)), go directly to the theater and grab a Q number.

## **The Q : The T/F door sales system**

- The "Q" system is your chance to get in at the door of a movie for which you were unable to reserve or purchase a ticket.
- Beginning 60 minutes (one hour and NO earlier) prior to the start of a film, eager movie-goers can get a "Q" number from the Queen at the venue. One Q per person.
- With your "Q" number in hand, you can leave the venue to grab some coffee or a bite to eat instead of being bound to the line.
- 15 minutes prior to the start of the film, you resume your place in the queue (get it?) and as the venue staff sees what seats are available, they will let people into the theater in Q number order.

## **Queen : Flamboyant Mobile Information Station**

- Found outside each venue, the Queen is your best resource to answer any and all fest related questions.
- This is also the person who hands out Q numbers 1 hour prior to the start of each screening
